OPENER - MIDDLE BREAK - CLOSER Basic

Circle left

*Sun tan toe, ticklin' the sand
Cold drink chillin' in my right hand
Men star right, roll it **once around**
Allemande the corner and **weave** on down

Swing a little girl and **promenade on home**
When the sun sinks low over the water
Everything gets hotter, when the sun goes down

FIGURE Basic, corner progression

Heads promenade and **go halfway** around
Down the middle you **pass thru**, then **wheel around**
Flutter wheel across, then **sweep 1/4** more
Pass thru and a **right & left thru**, turn 'em once more
Swing thru and then, **swing thru** again
Men run right and **promenade** and then
When the sun sinks low over the water
Everything gets hotter, when the sun goes down
