Circle left

Head (side) couples square thru four hands around you go
And when you're there go right and left thru
Veer left and circulate, it's straight ahead you know
Chain down the line, that's what you do
Slide thru and pass thru and trade by, swing
Swing that corner, promenade go 'round the ring
I'll sing my song and move along
I'm just a traveling minstrel man
