Circle Left

FIGURE

Heads Square Thru count 'em 4 hands round

You make a Right Hand Star

The Heads Star Left, roll it one time and then

Same pair and do a Dosado

Swing Thru and then the Boys Trade

Swing the corner lady round and Promenade

And when that certain look comes on her face

I know I can't replace it and she leaves me.

MIDDLE BREAK

Circle Left

I know she needs me,

About as much as I need someone else, which I don't.

Left Allemande the corner, Dosado you own

Left Allemande and Weave The Ring

Though I tried and tried to keep her tied and satisfied

She really didn't need me.

She needs no rhyme or reason, she'll go sailin' off on

Any old wind that blows.

CLOSER

Grand Square

Yes, she's restless

With a mind that can't resign herself to stay, So she won't.

And the men star right and you roll it around I say.

Allemande the corner and weave the ring.
