OPENER - MIDDLE BREAK - CLOSER Mainstream

Sides face, grand square

*Out in the country past the city limit sign
There's a honky tonk near the county line
The join starts jumpin every night when the sun goes down

Circle left

**They got dancing, women, music and smoke
Left allemande, you **swing** and **promenade** to the boogie
Boot scootin boogie

FIGURE (heads twice, sides twice) Mainstream, corner progression

The **heads promenade** you go **halfway** around
Square thru 4 go movin around
Swing thru you know and then you **spin the top**
Boys move up and **square thru 4** more
Trade by and then well the corner you **swing**
Swing that girl and **promenade** the ring
Get down, turn around, go to town
Boot scootin boogie
