## FIGURE:

Heads [sides] Square Thru and get four hands you do, Do Sa Do Swing Thru and then Boys Run Right, Bend the Line, Right & Left Thru Pass the Ocean, Recycle now, Swing the corner lady and Promenade I left that Colorado country morning and a Denver woman on my mind.

#### MIDDLE BREAK:

Circle Left. I remember standing at the door and looking back as she lay sleeping Left Allemande that corner, Turn your partner by the right hand Allemande Left and Weave the Ring Without a sound I turned around and softly kissed her goodbye

Swing the girl and Promenade I left that Colorado country morning and a Denver woman on my mind.

### CLOSER:

Well, four Ladies Promenade in the middle, around you go, run back and Swing Circle to the left, rolling around you go, Allemande that corner, Weave the ring To see that Colorado country morning, dusty roads and warm sunshine I left that Colorado country morning and a Denver woman on my mind.

## TAG:

And a Denver woman on my mind.
